



SOLDIERS' PAY. INFANTRY.

After all stoppages for Messing and Washing have been deducted, there remains on an average for the Soldier to spend as he chooses:—

In addition to above, Lodging, Food, Fuel, and Lighting are provided.

A Soldier in Hospital for wounds or illness contracted on Field Service, or injuries on Military Duty, receives free Medical Treatment. In other circumstances a stoppage of 7d. for each day in Hospital is made, but in cases of sickness caused by Military Service one half of the stoppage is remitted.

The Messing allowance, 3d. a day, is also stopped when a Soldier is in Hospital, except from injuries or sickness resulting from Active Service.

On Enlistment, a complete new Uniform and other Kit is issued free, and after 9 to 12 months' service a quarterly allowance is given for the upkeep of Uniform and Kit. A careful Soldier benefits by any of the allowance he saves.

Men of good character are granted Furloughs annually. While on furlough no stoppage is made for messing or washing and the man receives 6d. a day in lieu of rations, the additional cash issue during furlough thus amounting to 5/6 a week.

A leaflet, shewing terms of service, standards of height, age, &c., can be obtained at any Post Office or Barracks in the United Kingdom, or from any Recruiter.
