

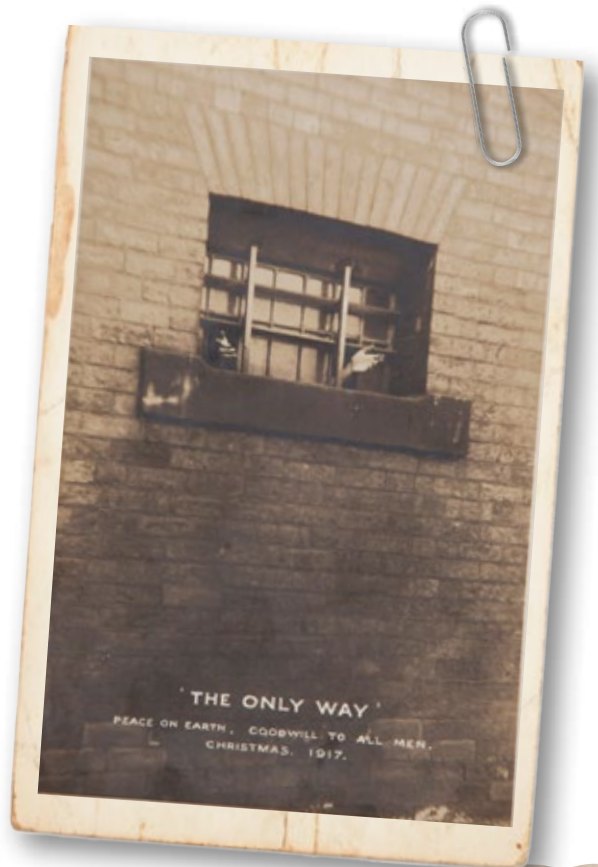

Thursday May 17th 1917

I mentioned sometime ago that we had a fellow very ill in the hospital. He has now passed away, & yesterday morning he was buried in the Friends Burial ground here. He was called Mr. James & came from Scrubbs here about 10 weeks ago & went straight into ^{the} hospital, being in a far developed stage of consumption, There is no doubt he has been killed before his time by the trial that many of us have passed through, & when a speaker at the Memorial Service said we honoured
